Creditable Enrolment Confirmation Fee

A non-refundable amount of \$150 per fee paying student is payable to the College on submission of the signed Enrolment Contract. This amount will be fully credited against tuition fees.

Secondary Textbook and Resource Allowance

The State Government provides the College with an allowance to offset the costs of textbooks, ICT items and other resources for secondary students, which the College purchases on the students' behalf. Families have the option of purchasing their own resources by requesting that the College Fees Advisor credit this allowance to their fee account. Families electing to do this will be obligated to purchase these resources at their own expense. Requests for an allowance credit must be received by no later than the end of November for existing student, or upon enrolment for new students. The allowance only covers a fraction of the full cost of these resources, therefore families do not find this option financially beneficial.
